



#### What is Rooted in Life?

- A national partnership between members of the Association for Multicultural Affairs in Transplantation (AMAT) and local chapters of National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), affectionately referred to as the "Divine Nine" (D9)
- A national African American outreach campaign to raise awareness about the impact of organ, eye and tissue donation
- A multi-media campaign designed to:
  - Drive internal advocacy: NPHC (D9) partners with AMAT members to drive advocacy within all nine organizations
  - Drive external outreach: NPHC (D9) helps drive outreach within the community
  - Engage crossover partners

#### How is this different?

- A collaborative national partnership between AMAT and local chapters of NPHC (D9), uniting efforts across the country
- A nationally branded campaign with the option for Organ Procurement Organizations (OPOs) to customize
- Consistent and cohesive messaging across the country for greater donation awareness
- Unified NPHC (D9) campaign with all 9 organizations actively participating
- Stories represent all aspects of donation: donor families, candidates waiting, living donors, organ and tissue transplant recipients, and loved ones of those who died waiting
- Measurable data through website analytics and NPHC engagement
